Guidelines for Hosting the Yule Log

*Thank you for hosting the Yule Log! Please review the guidelines below.

****If a Burn Ban is in effect, we will NOT have a bonfire and hosts will simply be asked to bring hot chocolate, cups, napkins and any sweets you would like to bring. We will contact you closer to the date to let you know whether or not we will be having a fire.**

Volunteers

Hosts are asked to provide enough volunteers to prepare and serve refreshments from 6:00 – 9:00 on Sundays – Thursdays and 6:00 – 10:00 on Fridays and Saturdays. Please have your first shift arrive at 5:30 to help set up.

Refreshments

Hosts are asked to provide:

- hot chocolate
- marshmallows (*large roasting kind, not small hot chocolate style*)
- cups (8 oz. only)
- napkins

The EmilyAnn will provide:

- hot water for hot chocolate
- skewers for roasting
- serving table

EmilyAnn Staff will have the fire started by 5:30. If you observe any problems with the Yule Log, please alert EmilyAnn Staff.

Entertainment
